REPORT OF THE INDEPENDENT AUDITOR TO THE MEMBERS OF GUARANTY TRUST BANK PLC

Report on the financial statements: We have audited the accompanying financial statements of Guaranty Trust Bank Plc ("the bank") and its subsidiaries (together "the group") which comprise the balance sheets as of 30 June 2011 and the profits and loss accounts and statements of cash flows for the period then ended and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory notes.

Directors' responsibility for the financial statements: The directors are responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with Nigerian Statements of Accounting Standards and with the requirements of the Companies and Allied Matters Act and the Banks and Other Financial Institutions Act and for such internal control, as the directors determine necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatements, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's responsibility: Our responsibility is to express an independent opinion on the financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with International Standards on Auditing. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform our audit to obtain reasonable assurance that the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgement, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the company's internal control. An audit also includes

evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the directors, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Opinion: In our opinion the accompanying financial statements give a true and fair view of the state of the financial affairs of the bank and the group as of 30 June 2011 and of their profits and cash flows for the period then ended in accordance with Nigerian Statements of Accounting Standards, the Companies and Allied Matters Act and the Banks and Other Financial Institutions Act.

for the year ended 31 December 2010 were audited by another auditor who relevant provisions of the Banks and Other Financial Institutions Act, or expressed an unmodified opinion on those financial statements on 21 July 2010 the other relevant circulars issued by the Central Bank of Nigeria. and on 21 March 2011 respectively.

Report on other legal requirements: The Companies and Allied Matters Act and the Banks and Other Financial Institutions Act require that in carrying out our audit we consider and report to you on the following matters. We confirm that:

i) we have obtained all the information and explanations which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purposes of our audit;

ii) the bank has kept proper books of account so far as appears from our examination of those books and we have received proper returns adequate for

the purposes of our audit from branches not visited by us;

iii) the bank's balance sheet and profit and loss account are in agreement with the books of account.

iv) our examination of loans and advances was carried out in accordance with the Prudential Guidelines for licensed banks issued by the Central Bank of Nigeria:

v) related party transactions and balances are disclosed in Note 42 to the financial statements in accordance with the Central Bank of Nigeria Circular BSD/1/2004;

Other matter: The financial statements for the period ended 30 June 2010 and vi) to the best of our information, the Bank has complied with the
